**Reg.: Calling officers/employees on Sundays/holidays**


This has reference to our previous letters placing our demands for not arbitrarily forcing the Officer Employees to work on holidays and national festivals. It is observed that the management has adopted hostile and intransigent posture to shun its illegal and stance. While, your good self has continued to maintain silence over the issue, the present CMO, Jharkhand/Bihar has issued an order directing the Branch Managers of classic branches to remain present on duty on 11.03.2017 which is a Holiday.


We would like to draw your attention to our joint letter dated 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 and reiterate our demands of not forcing the Officers/Workmen to work in the bank on declared Holidays. It is noted with grave concern that no response has been received from the management. This clearly depicts the arrogant & adamant attitude of the Management & their lack of concern for the sentiments & joint demands of the Federation & Association.

We again impress upon the management that paying due heed to our very legitimate demands the order calling Officers / Workmen of Jharkhand/Bihar on March 11, 2017 be withdrawn immediately failing which the Association & Federation will be forced to take all necessary steps and available means to prevent such unwarranted unjustified proposed meeting on holiday. The resultant consequences shall be at your risk.
