**Reg.: Protest against calling Classic Branch Managers on Holiday.**

We strongly protest your office instructions calling all Branch Managers of Classic Branches, Jharkhand & Bihar to be present for Branch Managers' meeting on holiday i.e. on 11<sup>th</sup> of March, 2017, the second Saturday. We do not find anything justified in calling such meeting on holiday. It would have made no difference if the meeting was called on any working day. But passing such instructions is deliberate attempt of the management reflecting its high handedness. This is in total violation of Bipartism.

Please do not forget that there are strong two organisations which represent 22,000 employees of this bank. We are capable enough to preserve and protect the rights and interest of the masses including our beloved institution. Hence, as responsible organisations, besides protecting the interest of our members, it is our duty to protect the settlement and understanding we arrived at. It is reiterated that the sanctity of **industry level Bipartism must be maintained** without reservation for peaceful and unhindered working of the Bank.

We therefore strongly protest the said instructions and request for immediate reversal of the same. Failing which, we shall be compelled to take all necessary steps and available means to prevent such unwarranted, unjustified proposed meeting on holiday. Any unrest caused due to this will be the sole responsibility of the Management.

We also demand to stop further calling staff to work on holidays.
